Priority of 1st Place winner will be as follows:

- Number of participants in division (example: Cadet Division with 4 competitors will take priority to Junior Division of same gender and weight class with only 2 competitors).
- In the event of same number of competitors in all divisions of same weight class and gender then the following order will take place for priority in receiving funding: **Priority 1:** Junior Division **Priority 2:** Cadet Division **Priority 3:** Senior Division.
- Athletes must compete with another person in their division to receive funding. If no match takes place funding will go to next person on priority list or division will be voided and competitor will receive refund for registration payment.
- ONLY 10 total spots available (5 Male and 5 Female)

Sunday, December 3, 2017, 10am-11am onsite at Chinook Middle School.

Qualifications to compete for athlete:

- **\$45** Registration Fee if you did NOT compete in the 2017 USAT Washington State Championship
- **\$25** Registration Fee if you competed in the 2017 USAT Washington State Championship
- Kukkiwon or USAT Black Belt Only. Cadet, Junior, Senior Sparring Athlete for 2018
- Current USAT Member
- Washington State Resident
- Must make weight for division
- Only allowed to compete in one weight class and age division.
- Must sign participation waiver.
- Minors must have legal guardian present to sign waiver.
- Approved gear: Taekwondo White Dobok with Black Vneck, forearm guard, shin guard, head gear (white or red & blue), mouth guard, groin protector, **Daedo Gen2 e-foot guard**, Daedo E-Hogu and E-Headgear Protectors will be provided. All divisions will use E-Hogu and E-Headgear

Qualifications for coaches:

- Donation request
- Current USAT Member in good standing
- Must pass background check/ Safesport
- USAT Coaching Rules & Dresscode

Requirements to receive funding:

- 1st Place in Qualifying Division
- Represent USA and Washington State and Register for 2018 U.S. Open in same division they competed in
- Sign and agree to with USAT Washington Team terms

1st Place winners will receive:

- Funding to assist with travel, registration, expenses for 2018 U.S. Open
- Washington State Team Taekwondo Uniform

Alternative Athlete Option:

- If the original 1st place winner declines or is not eligible for state funding then:
- Next qualifying 1st place winner will receive funding and support based on priority list.

Weigh In: Athlete must compete in the weight and age division they will compete in at 2018 U.S. Open.

- Approved gear: Taekwondo White Dobok with Black Vneck, forearm guard, shin guard, head gear (white approved or red & blue), mouth guard, groin protector, Daedo Gen 2 e-foot guard.
- Daedo E-Hogu and E-Headgear Protectors will be provided. All divisions will use E-Hogu and E-Headgear.

Rounds:

- Cadet Division: 3 Rounds 1:30 Minute Each
- Junior Division: 3 Rounds 1:30 Minute Each
- Senior Division: 3 Rounds 2 Minutes Each
